GUIDING QUESTIONS:

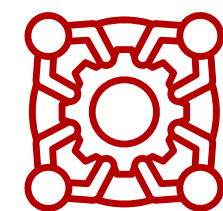
1. What does the future of B-BBEE look like in the next 10 years, and how can it remain relevant in driving transformation?

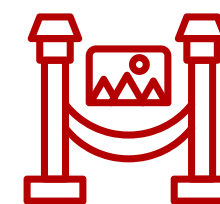

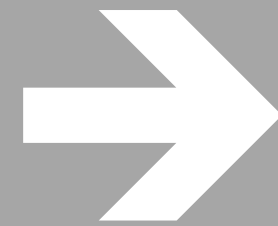
